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Phases of the 7E Instructional Model	Features in <i>PBIS</i>
Elicit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Think about the Big Question</i> at the unit level• <i>What do we think we know?</i> on the <i>Project Board</i>• <i>Understand the Question</i> at the <i>Learning Set</i> level
Engage	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introduction to the <i>Big Question</i> or <i>Challenge</i>• Introduction to each <i>Learning Set</i>
Explore	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Investigate</i>• <i>Explore</i>
Explain	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Read</i>• <i>Create an Explanation</i>• Science text boxes in <i>Investigate</i> and <i>Explore</i>• <i>Stop and Think</i>• <i>What's the Point?</i>• <i>What are we learning?</i> on the <i>Project Board</i>• <i>What is our evidence?</i> on the <i>Project Board</i>
Elaborate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Reflect</i>
Evaluate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Stop and Think</i>• <i>Reflect</i>• Rubric for the <i>Big Challenge</i> or <i>Question</i> online
Extend	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>What does it mean for the challenge or question?</i> on the <i>Project Board</i>• <i>Back to the Big Question/Challenge</i>• <i>Answer the Big Question</i> or <i>Address the Big Challenge</i>
