

## **PBIS** uses the 7E Instructional Model

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Phases of the 7E Instructional Model	Features in <i>PBIS</i>
Elicit	<ul> <li>Think about the Big Question at the unit level</li> <li>What do we think we know? on the Project Board</li> <li>Understand the Question at the Learning Set level</li> </ul>
Engage	<ul> <li>Introduction to the <i>Big Question</i> or <i>Challenge</i></li> <li>Introduction to each <i>Learning Set</i></li> </ul>
Explore	<ul><li>Investigate</li><li>Explore</li></ul>
Explain	<ul> <li>Read</li> <li>Create an Explanation</li> <li>Science text boxes in Investigate and Explore</li> <li>Stop and Think</li> <li>What's the Point?</li> <li>What are we learning? on the Project Board</li> <li>What is our evidence? on the Project Board</li> </ul>
Elaborate	• Reflect
Evaluate	<ul> <li>Stop and Think</li> <li>Reflect</li> <li>Rubric for the <i>Big Challenge</i> or <i>Question</i> online</li> </ul>
Extend	<ul> <li>What does it mean for the challenge or question? on the Project Board</li> <li>Back to the Big Question/Challenge</li> <li>Answer the Big Question or Address the Big Challenge</li> </ul>
