The *PBIS Integrity of Implementation Rubric* articulates what integrity means in an observable and measurable way. It describes variations for each component of *PBIS* in terms of the actions and behaviors, observable in the classroom, that are Highly Proficient (Ideal), Proficient, Emerging/Beginning, and Needs Improvement.
